

THE BRONZE TRAP LEAGUE

League Schedule: The First Sunday of each month beginning in November ending with the Class /Trophy shoot in April. The schedule may be modified so as not to conflict with other leagues, statutory holidays, etc.

Registration

Until 1 p.m., shoot starts at 10:00 a.m. or earlier if club rules allow (9:30 at Wilmot & 9:00 at Galt).

The fee is \$15.00 for 50 targets

The fee includes \$1.00 for hidden score purse, \$5.00 toward the League Fund for the purchase of merchandise to be awarded at the Trophy Shoot, leaving \$9.00 for the club holding the shoot that day.

The fee is \$10.00 for Junior shooters (\$1.00 for hidden score and \$9.00 for targets). The league fee is waived for Junior shooters. A Junior shooter is 18 or younger at the first shoot. *(A female shooter 18 or under may declare either Junior or Lady but not both – league fee waived for junior only)*

Club Scoring

1st – 4 points
2nd – 3 points
3rd – 2 points
4th – 1 point

A minimum of 7 shooters (high score) is to be fielded at each shoot, per club. If the minimum is not attained, a penalty of minus 3 birds off the lowest score will be assessed to the number of missing shooters. *e.g. If a club has 5 shooters only and the lowest score shot is a 40 then they will be assessed scores of 37 (40-3) and 34 (37-3) to complete the team score.*

Shooting Rules

A.T.A. rules will apply except as otherwise covered by the Bronze Trap League rules.

Each club to use the same trap setting, #2 on a White Flyer trap; other settings for other manufacturers apply in order to comply with A.T.A. rules. (Example: #1 for Beomat traps)

Unsafe Gun Handling

1st offense, the shooter is taken off the squad.

2nd offense, the shooter is disqualified from the League for the remainder of the year.

3rd offense, the shooter is disqualified from shooting at League shoots completely

Shooters Responsibility

Each shooter is responsible for checking the master sheet before leaving each shoot. Any score under protest should be corrected the day of the shoot; otherwise the master sheet stands.

Class / Trophy Shoot

This will be held at the April shoot. To be eligible for trophy or prizes, shooters must have shot a minimum of four (4) of the first five (5) shoots.

Classification of shooters will be based on the overall average after the March shoot. Abnormally low scores may be disregarded and known ability may be considered by the league committee. Previous year Class winners will be advanced to the next class regardless of average.

High Average Gun – Highest average shooter for the year including the Trophy Shoot. To be eligible for the High Average Gun Trophy a shooter must have competed in the first 5 shoots plus the trophy shoot. This award is based on average over all six (6) shoots.

Note - All shooters are welcome to participate in the April shoot for fun and team score.

Ties:

Ties for class champion or high average gun will be shot in-groups of 10 targets (2 from each station) until best score out of 10 wins.

Ties for team trophy will be settled by each team electing 1 shooter to shoot best of 10 targets as above. If tie remains, two new shooters will shoot for best of 10, etc.

Trophies and Awards

A trophy will be awarded to the winning club (most points) and is to be held until the following League Season. Trophy donated by F.M. Shooting Sports (Frank McCaig).

High Average Gun will be awarded First draw or pick of the table

High Lady (Class shoot Winner) will be awarded Second draw or pick of the table

High Junior (Class shoot Winner) will be awarded Third draw or pick of the table

Class A Winner will be awarded Fourth draw or pick of the table

Class B Winner will be awarded Fifth draw or pick of the table

Class C Winner will be awarded Sixth draw or pick of the table

Class D Winner will be awarded Seventh draw or pick of the table

Anyone winning Classes A,B,C,D, Lady, Junior or High Average Gun will be removed from the random prize table draw.

Prize Table Draw will be awarded by a random draw (first drawn = first pick of the table, and so on) until all names are drawn or the table is empty. Only the persons eligible for the Trophy Shoot are eligible for the Prize Table Draw.

Individual clubs may modify the above prize draw procedure if necessary to suit the restrictions within their own clubs.

Pins will be awarded to any shooter eligible to shoot in the trophy shoot.

Shooters participating in all six shoots will be entered in a separate special prize draw.

Classification:

Class A – 88.0% and over

Class B – 81.0% to 87.9%

Class C – 73.0% – 80.9%

Class D – 72.9% and down

Shooting in Advance:

Competitors that are not able to attend a particular shoot will be allowed to shoot in advance on a regular shooting day, at the club holding the next shoot, between the past league shoot and the upcoming event they cannot attend. Competitors must announce their intention to shoot ahead and pay entrance fees in advance of shooting. This shooting ahead will only be allowed **twice** during the season.

Clubs are under no obligation to provide any special arrangements, outside of regular shooting activities, to provide for this option.

Note: The trophy shoot may be shot in advance for team score but will not be eligible for individual trophy or prizes.
